SUMMARY: Under the direction of the Outdoor Services Lead Mechanic, perform a variety of skilled and semi-skilled tasks to accomplish the repair and maintenance of a variety of equipment. Assist and perform welding and metal fabrication. Assist in the training and safe operation of department equipment.
