SUMMARY: Responsible for providing musical theatre instruction in roles as assigned, including Director, Assistant Director, Technical Director, Pit Director, Vocal Director, Choreographer, or some combination of these and other duties.

DESCRIPTION OF JOB TASKS
1. Provide instruction, direction, and supervision for Summer Musical Theatre project.
2. Develop, plan, prepare, and implement: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Rehearsal content, format, structure, and schedule. b. Individualized instruction and supervision as relevant for student leaders and individuals in principal roles. c. Rehearsal and technical/construction activities. d. Rehearsal, preparation, and performance activities.
3. Instruct students in large, small, and one-on-one situations.
4. Provide feedback and supervision to cast members, student leaders, and student technical staff.
5. Create a learning environment which maximizes instructional opportunity, supervises the behavior and well-being of students in rehearsal and performance settings, and provide notes or corrections when appropriate.
6. Oversee all aspects of preparation, rehearsal, and performance as relates to assigned role/duties, to help mount a successful musical theatre production.
7. Monitor student growth and progress, adapt support as needed, and maintain documentation pertinent to attendance and participation in required activities.
8. Communicate students' progress, needs, and obligations with parents/guardians and other staff as needed.
9. Collaborate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. With colleagues, support personnel, and administrators, to enhance instruction and improve student outcomes. b. With colleagues in team meetings and discussions.
