



CF - SCHOOL BUILDING ADMINISTRATION

Principals shall act as the chief administrative officers of their schools. They shall be responsible for and shall have authority over the actions of their students, employees, and visitors.

Principals shall be responsible for achieving the long- and short-range educational objectives of the District as they pertain to students and staff in their buildings. Principals shall be responsible for management of the District's comprehensive standards-based education program at their schools consistent with applicable laws, District policies and regulations, administrative guidelines and procedures, and supervisor directives, and shall rigorously monitor and modify the program to best enable students to meet or exceed District and state standards.

Principals shall have the authority to make school rules consistent with District policies and regulations that are deemed necessary to ensure the opportunity for students to take full advantage of the educational experiences provided.
