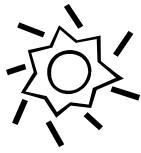

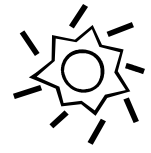
## REGISTRATION DETAILS

- **WEEK 1—June 8-12. WEEK 2—June 15-19** Classes are held from 9 AM—12 PM each day.
- **TUITION** is \$65 per week, or \$130 for two weeks. Students qualified for Reduced lunch prices will pay \$35/week or \$70/two weeks. Students qualified for Free lunch prices will pay \$25/week or \$50/two weeks.

# Primary (K-2) Class Descriptions

## Week 1 (June 8-12) & Week 2 (June 15-19) ~ 9 AM-12 PM



### 1. African Safari

WEEK 1 or 2

Every day will be a new discovery of Ancient Egyptian pyramids and mummies in the North, coral reefs in the South, and the Serengeti National Park and animal safari. Be prepared to make a splash over the Zambezi Falls. You don't want to miss a day of this journey as we end our week in Madagascar!

### 2. Art Around the World

WEEK 1 or 2

Looking to take a trip? Take a journey around the world, exploring art at every stop along the way. We'll find inspiration in Africa, China, Japan, Mexico, and more! Come join us for a week of artistic adventure! Paint, sculpt and color your way around the world!

### 3. Artsy Animals

In this hands-on art class we will explore animals as art. We will use a number of different materials like paper, paint, pastels, clays and plastic to create our artsy animals. Kids will end the week with new friends and new recipes for both snacking and fun!

### 7. Take-Apart Junk Art

Students will dismantle, stitch, glue, bend, shape and stick together landfill bound "junk" into sculptures like a Can Character or a Trashasaurus Rex. ### 8. Creative Quilting

Teacher: Ken Arledge

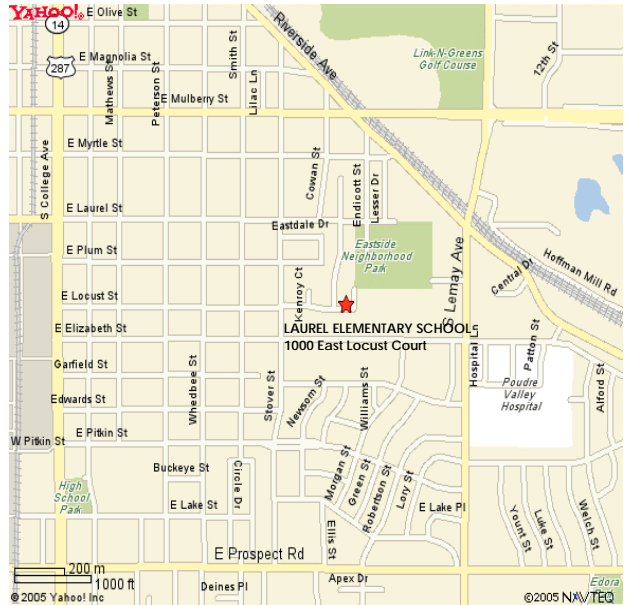
