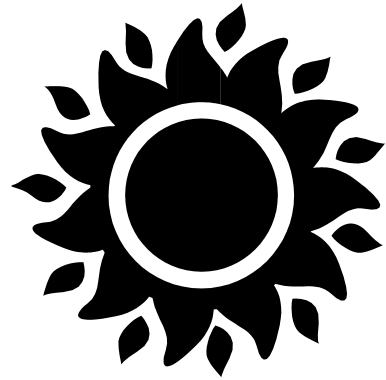

REFUNDS
