Boundary Steering Committee Met Twice in November

The Boundary Changes Steering Committee continues to analyze and discuss scenarios to better balance high school enrollment in Poudre School District. The Committee, which met twice in early November, has reviewed 18 scenarios to date.

At the November 12 meeting, the Steering Committee updated the Review Committee about the overall boundary changes process, what has been completed and what is in store for the upcoming months.

Using feedback from the Review Committee, Steering Committee members will continue discussing scenarios at a meeting scheduled for 5 to 7:30 p.m., Thursday, December 6, at the Johannsen Support Services Center, 2407 LaPorte Ave.

The Steering Committee, co-chaired by Jim Sarchet, PSD Assistant Superintendent of Business Services and Kellie Nuber, parent, includes principals, teachers and parents representing elementary schools, junior high and high schools. The committee also includes five non-voting support members (PSD staff and consultant).

The Review Committee is comprised of parent/community members and principals or assistant principals from each school.

The two committees are studying high school boundaries with the goal of changing boundaries to better balance enrollment in Poudre School District. The Steering Committee is developing possible scenarios, while the Review Committee will give feedback to the Steering Committee.
