## Representative Updates

### SIT – Budget Info

- Budgeted \$38,000 for non-compensation
- 15.3% budget cut
- 19.4% enrollment drop\*
  - Student Based Budget implications:
    - Funded @ 299 students
    - 9/16/09 we have 290 students
    - ~\$45,000 owed if stays this way through October count\*
    - Can possibly be paid back in three years
- Field trips for the year were discussed
  - As a Title 1 school, we are fortunate to have the Bohemian Foundation pay transportation costs for two field trips per quarter
- The Crisis Response notebook was reviewed and teachers were asked to review Stranger Danger strategies with their students

- As a Title 1 school we have the opportunity to receive \$13,000 for possible after-school tutoring and/or an August “jump start” tutoring

**Sam’s Update**

- PSD’s Facilities Usage study was mentioned. Though Beattie was not directly mentioned for possible closure, repurposing or consolidation, obviously any changes will have domino effects on every school to some extent
- We have two assemblies scheduled in October and one in April
- PSD will be working on adopting a new reading textbook for elementaries. Any parent wishing to be considered for possible inclusion on that committee should see Sam
- The School Improvement Plan and Accreditation Report are due later this month and will be posted on the school website
- The branding survey mentioned last month is about to come on line, and the staff very much appreciates the efforts of any parents who complete it
