- Volunteer in your student's classroom or for your favorite grade level—your help is always appreciated.

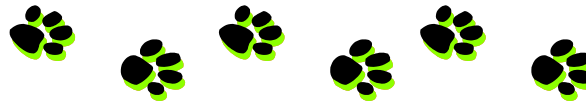
## New Policy and Procedures regarding Volunteers in our Schools

- The addition of a new procedure requiring criminal background checks for **all** volunteers, including one-time and long-time volunteers.

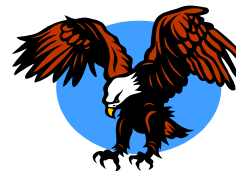
