

Moore Mentoring Program

Thank you for your interest in the Moore Mentoring Program. We are thrilled to have Colorado State University Students as a part of this program at Moore Elementary School.

We are currently looking for CSU Students to mentor one student, one day a week for approximately 45 minutes. We would like for the CSU Students to begin during the spring 2008 semester and continue to mentor a student until the end of that semester. If you were still interested in continuing the following year, we would gladly maintain that. Moore is located very close to Colorado State University. We are just west of Moby Gym (west on Elizabeth, right on Skyline and a left on Orchard - Moore is on the south side of Orchard). This is approximately a 5 minute drive from Moby and approximately a 10 minute bike ride from Moby.

We like to try and bring in students that can mentor during the Moore student's lunch period that is generally from 11:55-1:00 (depending on the grade level). However, we are flexible enough to make exceptions based on both students' schedules.

If you are definitely interested in pursuing a student to mentor at Moore, please take a look at the manual that I have included, save it to your computer, fill it out to the best of your ability and return it to me as an attachment. I apologize for this application not being a template to fill out on the computer as of yet. You will also need to do a background check through the Poudre School District website. This is an extremely quick process...

Once I've received your application, I will contact you to set up a 30 minute training meeting where we will discuss the logistics of the program, the time that works best for you and the student you would like to mentor.
