

Olander Executive PTO Minutes

1. Treasurer Report

- Our checking account balance is over \$10,000. Ideas on ways to spend portions of this are welcome.
- Safeway Back to School receipt money to come in soon. It was brought up that this program is one that should be documented with instructions for next year's PTO Board to maximize its potential profits.

2. R.E.A.C.H. → S.O.A.R.

- After meeting with a lawyer, we are clear to proceed with our own improved version of the Read-A-Thon. Conversation regarding prizes, brochures, and the mailing system followed.
- Timeline of program will be after CSAP, with details to be worked out and notes to go home in Friday Folders.

3. Soc Hop Wrap-Up

4. Spring Book Fair/Runza Chili?

- The pro/cons of adding a chili dinner to the book fair was discussed. Nancy Ozzello, who has conducted similar chili dinners, gave her insight. Aspects brought up were-- possible money maker (as in the case of Bauder's chili dinner), possibility of a bigger draw to book fair, but also more volunteers needed and more work overall. No decision made at this time.

5. Spring Family Fun Events

- Skating at ODs, evening of Friday, April 20th to be followed-up on with Rachel Obrys.
- It was discovered that group seating at a Rockies game is being done by Rocky Mountain H.S. as a fundraiser for their baseball team. Nancy Ozzello explained their arrangement to sell tickets to two games (Sun, April 29, vs. Braves and Sat, Sept. 15, vs. Marlins) for \$22. It was felt that this could be promoted to Olander students as well. Details to be worked out.
- Message was left to discuss a possible Sri Thai event.

- Meeting with Brian was postponed to discuss the system and is rescheduled for Thursday morning. Bill has researched Johnson Elementary's system. He also reviewed the current PSD system, possibly to make future improvements there as well.
