

# Olander PTO Minutes

It was suggested that the money go towards possible benches around the flag pole. They are also going to decorate/donate trash barrels for recycling in the cafeteria.

## 3. Sound System

- Mike Robinson presented and demonstrated the sound system that PTO is buying from him. He made the unit self-contained, portable, and easy to secure, meeting the needs of all our school events.

- Susan Robinson handed off the Soc Hop event folder to give to the next coordinator. This year's dance netted \$917.

- **Skating at ODS**, Friday, April 20<sup>th</sup>. Details to come and will include karaoke.
- **Rockies Baseball** tickets, through Rocky Mountain High's baseball fundraiser, can be purchased through Nancy Ozzello. Tickets to two games (Sun., April 29 vs. Braves, and Sat., Sept. 15 vs. Marlins) can be purchased for \$22. A block of seats for Olander families will be provided.
