



ADD - SAFE SCHOOLS

Following consultation with the District Accountability Committee, School Accountability Committees, the Security and School Operations Department, and other appropriate district and community resources, Poudre School District shall develop safe schools plans that include procedures for staff in crisis prevention and management. These plans will include but are not limited to:

1. A designated and trained building crisis response team
2. Lockdown, fire, evacuation, and severe weather procedures
3. Access and building check-in procedures
4. Staff training and a plan for yearly drills of procedures

Building principals shall be responsible for the supervision and implementation of the safe school program at their schools.

In accordance with C.R.S. 22-32-109.1 (2)(b), an annual safety report shall be submitted to the Colorado State Board of Education and made available to the public.
