



EEAC-R - BUS ROUTING

1. Bus operators must drive the assigned routes unless factors such as student health or road conditions require a temporary route revision. In such case, the bus operator should notify the dispatcher by radio. If a route revision must be made for a longer time due to factors such as bridge work or street closures, the bus operator must provide details to the routing and planning office upon completion of the route.
2. Bus stops will be planned and located on public roads in compliance with Colorado Department of Education regulations and state laws.
3. Only students assigned to a bus are permitted to ride on that bus. Other students will be permitted to ride only if they provide the bus operator with a bus pass signed by the building principal. Bus operators must not allow non-assigned students on their buses if such students do not have required permission or if there is no seating capacity on the bus to accommodate the student.
