



EEAG - STUDENT TRANSPORTATION IN PRIVATE VEHICLES

Volunteer drivers of small vehicles used to transport students to school-sponsored activities shall:

1. Receive authorization from the principal/site manager.
2. Operate a vehicle that is in safe mechanical working condition.
3. Have a valid Colorado driver's license. A copy of the driver's license shall be on file at the site.
4. Carry minimum limits of vehicle insurance as determined by the district's risk manager. A record of this insurance shall be on file at the site.
5. Assure that a functioning seat belt is provided for every student passenger. The driver shall not begin to move the vehicle until the driver and all passengers are belted.

When private vehicles are used to transport students on field trips, an adult sponsor shall ride in each vehicle. Adult sponsors shall be approved by the principal/site manager.
