



GBGD - WORKERS' COMPENSATION

The district is self-funded for workers' compensation. Any employee injured on the job shall notify the supervisor within 48 hours. The department shall notify the district's risk manager within three working days.

Any employee sustaining a work-related injury shall be treated only by the district's designated physician in order to be eligible for benefits. If a physician other than that designated by the district treats the employee's work-related injury, the employee's claim may not be accepted, and the employee may have to pay all expenses incurred for the injury.
