



JLC-R - STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES AND REQUIREMENTS

(HEALTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE)

Poudre School District shall have a health advisory committee composed of licensed representatives of the medical, dental, and public health communities to assist the district with any health-related questions that the school district might wish to place before it.

The committee will be composed of 10 members. It is recommended that the following areas be represented:

1. Pediatrics--at least one member
2. Family medicine--at least one member
3. A representative from the department of health
4. Four members representing other health professions to be selected based on the perceived needs of the district at the time the appointments are made
5. Poudre School District nursing services--one member
6. Poudre School District special education administration--one member
7. Poudre School District curriculum specialist for health education

The term of service shall be three years with no more than one-third of the committee being appointed in any one year. Members may be reappointed to another term of service at the discretion of the committee.

The chairman and all other officers will be elected annually by the committee.
