

The Poudre School District Board of Education met for its work session meeting on February 24, 2026, at the Johannsen Support Services Center. The agenda for this meeting included:

Superintendent Report

During his report, Brian Kingsley once again recognized Chief Institutional Effectiveness Officer Dr. Dwayne Schmitz who is retiring this month. He also noted that while PSD faces challenges ahead as a result of budget reductions and declining enrollment, great things are still happening across the district. He also showcased a video highlighting how students build Individual Career Academic Plans (ICAP) in Xello.

Informal Reports / Discussion Items

The board unanimously passed a resolution that authorized the district to implement a Reduction in Force if it becomes necessary to balance next year's budget. The board reiterated that this does not mean layoffs are happening. It means the district now has the Board's approval to begin those steps if needed.

Dr. Schmitz, during his second District Ends presentation to the board, highlighted several achievements for the district as well as opportunities for continued improvement. The board approved the monitoring report unanimously.

The board unanimously passed a resolution for the district to recover exclusive chartering authority. It was clarified during the process that this would not change the authorization of current charter schools within PSD boundaries.

The board also moved two items from the consent agenda to action items: air conditioning installation and other improvements to Webber and Leshner Middle Schools. After details were shared about these projects, both items passed unanimously.
