

The Poudre School District Board of Education met for its business meeting on March 24, 2026 at the Johannsen Support Services Center. The agenda for this meeting included:

### **Board recognitions and resolutions**

The Board began its meeting by unanimously approving a [resolution in support of Transgender Day of Visibility](#), with Superintendent Brian Kingsley sharing quotes from PSD students.

### **Superintendent report**

During his [superintendent report](#), Kingsley prepared the board for two of the topics on the agenda, namely a report about summer construction projects funded by the debt-free mill levy override, as well as an update about the state budget.

He also played a video from a [recent makers fair at Bacon Elementary School](#).

### **Consent Agenda and Action Items**

The board passed its consent agenda unanimously. It then went on to approve several action items, including:

- Executive Limitation Policy EL 2.8, passed unanimously
- McGraw Boiler Project, passed unanimously
- Approval for Purchase of Musical Instruments and Equipment, passed unanimously
- Recommendation for External Audit Services Engagement for FY2025-26, passed 5-2

### **Informal Reports / Discussion items**

The Board received a [report about summer projects funded by the mill-levy override](#). This included a number of projects across the district, ranging from athletic facility improvements to roof replacements and more.

The Board also [received a budget update](#) and more information on the [economic forecast released by the State of Colorado](#). This included the fact that the economic outlook has worsened since December, and future school funding will likely face ongoing pressure despite short-term fixes being proposed at the state level. However, it was noted in this presentation that PSD has already taken proactive steps to reduce costs, putting it in a relatively strong position but more reductions are expected.
