Access your student's CMAS score reports through Family Portal in June

We are proud of how much our students have learned and grown this school year. In April, students in grades 3-8 took the Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS) tests in English language arts and math, and students in grades 5, 8, and 11 participated in science assessments. Students who qualify for alternate assessments took the Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) test in grades 3-11. Integrated Services will communicate information about DLM performance reports.

CMAS Score Reports Available June 11

Preliminary CMAS performance reports will be available starting June 11 through the Pearson Family Portal, a secure online platform that allows you to view your student's results from Colorado's statewide assessments.
