



## **JKB - DETENTION OF STUDENTS AFTER SCHOOL HOURS**

A school administrator or designee may detain a student for disciplinary reasons after school hours as an alternative to exclusionary discipline such as a suspension. Reasons for discipline include violation of the code of conduct and behavior that is disruptive, as per District Policy JK – Student Discipline and Rights of Students with Disabilities/Procedures Regarding Discipline of Students with Disabilities. The parent/caregiver must be notified of the detention one school day prior to the student's detention.

Students who serve a detention after school must never be left alone during their detention. Their supervision must be provided or arranged for by an administrator or designee.
