
## Debt Free Milly Levy Override (DFMLO)



- \$49M Mill Levy Override (MLO)
- Approved by voters in November of 2024
- Grows with inflation \$50M for FY25-26
- Designed for recruitment/retention, school maintenance, classroom resources, and small neighborhood schools

## Implementation of Debt Free Mill Levy





<sup>\*</sup> Equivalent to a 5% increase across all employee groups, however employee groups may apply the actual increase based on their specific needs.

Actual allocations may differ based on the actual pro-rata share of total compensation by employee group.

### Allocation of DFMLO FY25-26



- \$ 21.1M Staffing existing maintenance and operations staff
  - 4.7M Charters pro-rata share
  - 1.8M Information and Technology replacement cycles and enhancements
  - 0.3M Security Upgrades replacement cycles cameras, door access, etc...
  - 2.7M Bus and Support Fleet replacement cycles
  - 0.8M Child Nutrition and Custodial Equipment maintenance/replacement
  - 2.7M General Facilities and Outdoor maintenance, smaller non-construction
  - 13.0M Capital/Large Projects 5-year plan
  - 3.2M Balance for Air Conditioning

Total \$50.3M FY2025-26
