Policy Title: Accountability of the Superintendent

Because the Superintendent is the Board's official link to operational achievement and conduct, the Superintendent is vested with full authority over and accountability for management and staff. Accordingly:

- The Board shall not give directions or instructions to persons who report directly or indirectly to the Superintendent, except the District's Legal and Policy Counsel. The Board shall be able to consult with Legal and Policy Counsel as it deems necessary or advisable.
 - a. The Superintendent may direct requests for information made by Board members to members of the Superintendent's Cabinet or other appropriate District leadership. Such appropriate District staff may respond directly to Board members. The Superintendent will be copied or otherwise notified of all such responses.
- 2. The Board shall not evaluate, either formally or informally, any staff other than the Superintendent.
