Based on current federal and state funding, Poudre School District will continue to provide a no-cost breakfast and lunch for most students during the 2025-2026 school year.

Research shows students perform better in school when they are not hungry. By providing breakfast and lunch to all children, we support their learning.

PSD's Child Nutrition program is recognized nationally as a leader in providing high quality and healthy daily meal options. Our school meals exceed the U.S. Department of Agriculture guidelines for healthy school meals. When families choose school meals, our schools get more funding, and our communities can connect over mealtimes.

While most students will continue to receive free meals at school, it's still essential for families to complete the Free and Reduced-Price Meal Benefits application. Submitting this information annually helps our district secure vital state and federal funding that directly benefits our schools. These funds help cover meal program costs, support after-school activities, and expand nutritional services. In addition, eligible families may qualify for Summer EBT benefits, reduced school fees, assistance with utilities, and other valuable resources. By providing your household income information, you are helping ensure both your student and their school receive the full support they deserve.
