



Phase 1 School Meal Plan for Poudre School District

Thank you for helping us serve Phase 1 School Meals as safely and efficiently as possible. In order to achieve our goal, we have made the following plans in conjunction with our district administration and local health authorities effective **August 31, 2020**.

What is the GOAL of Poudre School District Child Nutrition Department?

Our goal for Phase 1 School Meals in PSD is to ensure that:

- **All students receive daily school meals in a safe environment so that they are ready to succeed in academic activities at home.**
- **We provide healthy & nutritious breakfast and lunch meals for Drive Through Service**

Where will meals be served?

Meals will be served at more than 75 school sites and mobile locations throughout the district. All sites are drive through, grab and go pickup. Locations can be found at <https://www.psdschools.org/psd2020-21/mealsremotelearning>. Students do not have to get meals from their home school- meals can be picked up at any location!

What is the schedule for meal service?

Meals will be served from 11:00 - 1:00 Monday - Friday at each location.

Who can pick up a meal?

Parents/Guardians and/or students can pick up Grab and Go meals for students and siblings age 18 and younger. At this time we cannot offer meals to adults.

Where can school meal menus be found?

Menus for Phase 1 School Meals will be available on <https://psdschools.nutrislice.com/>. Contact the Child Nutrition office at 970-490-3557 for more information. Please note, only one breakfast and one lunch may be picked up per day, per person.

Can my student still receive a modified meal?

Students who have a meal modification plan on file will still be provided a meal that meets their special dietary requirements. These meals **must be preordered** by calling or emailing Becky Wiggins at rwiggins@psdschools.org, 970-490-3348.

Are meals offered free to all students?

Yes, as of August 31, 2020 meals are offered free to all students and siblings (18 years and younger) through December 2020. Each child can pick up one breakfast and one lunch per day at no cost.

Do I still need to apply for Free and Reduced Price meals for my students? If not, how do I apply for my student(s)?

No, it is not too late to apply for meal benefits. Applications are accepted and processed throughout the school year. If you think your family may qualify for meal benefits, please apply online at www.myschoolapps.com. You do not need to complete a separate application for each student- only one application is needed per family. Though meals are now served to all students free of charge we encourage you to apply for the meal program as your family may then be eligible for fee waivers and reduced fees with some extracurricular programs outside of PSD. Approved meal applications also help PSD with funding.
