X	Replacement Planner	\$3.50	To cover all or a portion of the cost of the planners.	Students who do not pay will not receive a replacement copy of the notebook and will instead be provided with a photo copy as needed.
1	Time for Kids: 5 th Grade	\$6.00	To cover the cost of the subscriptions.	Students who do not pay will not receive their own copy of the subscription and will instead have access to a classroom copy during school hours that cannot be taken off school grounds.
N/A	Art Sketchbook	\$1.75	To cover the cost of the sketchbook	All students will receive a sketchbook regardless of whether payment is made.
1	Recorder: 5 th Grade Music	\$5.95	To cover all or a portion of the cost of the recorder.	Students who do not pay will not receive their own recorder and will instead have access to a recorder during school hours. The recorder must be returned after each class.

5	5 th Grade Musical	\$15.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of the 5 th grade musical, including but not limited to, a t-shirt, sheet music, props and costumes.	Students who do not pay will not be allowed to participate.
