N/A	Teen Living: Cooking Lab	\$10.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of ingredients to be used by all students in the cooking lab.	All students will have access to the ingredients regardless of whether payment is made.
N/A	Crafts Class	\$10.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of expendable supplies to be used by all students in the class including, but not limited to, paracord, hemp twine, wooden puzzle and sketchbook.	All students will receive or have access to the expendable the supplies regardless of whether payment is made.
1	Art Class	\$5.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost expendable supplies to be used by all students in the class including, but not limited to, sketchbook, pencils, erasers, markers and blending stumps.	Students who do not pay or furnish their own supplies will instead have access to a classroom set of supplies during school hours that cannot be taken off school grounds.

N/A	Photography Class	\$10.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of students printing their photographs.	All students will be allowed to print their photographs regardless of whether payment is made.
1	Pottery Class	\$10.00	To cover the cost of expendable supplies to be used by all students in the class including, but not limited to, clay and glaze.	Students who do not pay or furnish their own supplies will not be able to fire and take home their projects, and will instead have their projects recycled.
