1	Chamber Orchestra Uniform	\$25.00	To cover the cost of black shirts worn during required performances.	Students who do not pay or furnish their own black shirt will instead be provided with a black shirt for performances, which must be returned after each performance.
1	Intro/Exploring, Engineering/Applying Technology/Robotics Supplies	\$18.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of expendable supplies for all students to use including, but not limited to, 3d printing filament, PLA/ABS plastics as well as CNC-Milling project materials.	Students who do not pay or furnish their own supplies will instead have access to a classroom set of supplies during school hours that cannot be taken off school grounds.
1	Musical Theater Supplies	\$25.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of expendable supplies for all students to use including, but not limited to, costumes, scripts and set supplies necessary for musical theater productions.	Students who do not pay will not be able to participate in the cast and will serve in the technical crew.

1	Pottery Supplies	\$15.00	To cover the cost of the students purchasing their own expendable supplies including, but not limited to, clay and glaze.	Students who do not pay or furnish their own supplies will not be able to fire and take home their projects and will instead have their projects recycled.
1	Instrument Rental Fee	\$50.00	Rental charge to offset the cost of maintenance and repair of musical instruments. The charge is based on the average cost of yearly instrument maintenance and repair.	Students who do not pay or furnish their own instrument will not be able to participate in the course.
1	7 th & 8 th Grade Orchestra Uniform	\$10.00	To cover the cost of purchasing, upkeep, repair, and replacement of uniforms.	Students who do not pay will be provided a uniform for performances, which must be returned after each performance.
1	8 th Grade Concert Choir Uniform	\$10.00	To cover the cost of purchasing, upkeep, repair, and replacement of uniforms.	Students who do not pay will be provided a uniform for performances, which must be returned after each performance.
1	7 th & 8 th Grade Select Choir	\$25.00	To cover the cost of purchasing, upkeep, repair, and replacement of uniforms.	Students who do not pay will be provided a uniform for performances, which must be returned after each performance.
