1	Architecture and Building Supplies	\$15.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of purchasing expendable supplies for student projects including, but not limited to, wood, nails, and glue.	Students who do not pay will not receive the supplies and will instead be provided an educationally comparable alternative assignment building with cardboard rather than wood and utilizing textbook assignments.
1	6 th Grade Art Supplies	\$4.00	To cover the cost of the students purchasing their own sketchbook.	Students who do not pay will not receive the sketchbook. Students may provide their own sketchbook or will instead be provided with loose leaf paper.
1	Art 1/Art 2 Supplies	\$5.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of purchasing expendable supplies for all students to use including, but not limited to, drawing paper, paint, pencils, brushes, tape, chalk, oil pastels, watercolors, colored pencils, block print plates, and ink.	Students who do not pay will not utilize new supplies. Instead, they will be able to access loose-leaf paper and used art supplies located in the classroom.
1	Organizational Planner	\$3.50	To cover the cost of planners used by the 6 th & 7 th grade classes.	Students who do not pay for a planner will not receive a planner. Students will be able to purchase their own or utilize an online planner.

1	Pottery and Sculpture Supplies	\$10.00 per semester	To cover all or a portion of the cost of purchasing expendable supplies for student projects including, but not limited to, clay, glaze, and tools.	Students who do not pay will have their work recycled rather than fired.
1	Robotics Engineering Supplies	\$20.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of purchasing expendable supplies for the class robot project including, but not limited to, the replacement of NXT brick, Legos, sensors, and motors.	Students who do not pay will focus on more theoretical and computer-based activities instead of hands-on activities and will not be allowed to use the 3D printer.
1	Woodworking Supplies	\$15.00	To cover the cost of purchasing expendable supplies used for student projects including, but not limited to, lumber, nails, and glue.	Students who do not pay will not receive the supplies and instead will use cardboard to complete their project.
1	Computer Science	\$15.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of purchasing expendable supplies for student projects including, but not limited to 3D filament and circuit boards.	Students who do not pay will not receive the supplies and will instead only participate in the digital aspects of computer science, which will primarily include research and coding. They will not be allowed to use the 3D printers.
2	Choir: Born with Vocals T-Shirt	\$15.00	To cover the cost of the t-shirt and screening.	Students who do not pay will not receive the t-shirt and will instead borrow a music department shirt from a previous year.

N/A	CLP Rocks Guitar Club	\$10.00	To cover the costs of the program including, but not limited to, music and strings.	Students will be allowed to participate regardless of whether payment is made.
5	FIRST® LEGO® League Club	\$75.00 ^C	To cover the cost of the program including, but not limited to, FIRST® LEGO® League registration, materials and supplies.	Students who do not pay will not be allowed to participate.
5	Science Olympiad	\$25.00	To offset the cost of building materials used in the club.	Students who do not pay will not be allowed to participate.
