II. PSD Gifted Program Happenings (Semester 1)

- Elementary and Secondary Professional Learning Days - Got time to work as a GT cohort which is new.
- New work at elem sites - Examples include Passion Projects with Ottercares, STEM enrichment,, Stock Market Game, Odyssey of the Mind, enrichment book groups, SEL programming, etc.
- New work at secondary sites - Examples include more connections to college/career interests, college field trips, year two of Boltz GT WIN, SEL programming, etc.

III. Colorado Department of Education_Gifted Ed Updates - @ Regional and State Levels

- Regional Gifted Family Forum Canceled - The Nov. 2nd event was canceled due to lack of registration.
- 3150 Funding Formula - There is a committee working on this allocation formula to make sure every AU gets a fair piece of the grant pie. The leaders of the CDE Gifted Ed office jump started this work.
- Gifted Endorsement - Only UNC, DU, UCCS, and Pueblo are approved by CDE licensure to offer the gifted endorsement program. However, Pueblo has hired an outside entity to run those classes which is raising questions.
