

 - They are going to adjust the HS planning guide to offer more detailed Pathways course plan templates to help students Graduate With Options.
 - Will increase communication to include 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th grade families to know these options are available.
 - PSD will choose ONE point of entry for students to do course requests - either Synergy or Xello. Will go into effect at ALL schools in Jan. 2025.
