GAB - Making Changes (Update)	KM met with John Cope, Executive Director of Communication on 10/3/2025. Shared ALL of our ideas and thoughts from May 2025. Advocated for much more active communication for transition parents John listened well. Then he shared information about how PSD communications and transition work is going to potentially shift soon. Info from John is listed below in no particular order: Our PSD School to Home communications vendor is changing. That will allow for better mass communication from PSD and departments and schools. School/district websites will be changing too. There will be more PSD-central oversight (ex: PSD will be able to add events to school calendars online, will have some content on all websites that PSD controls and can keep there, can norm more of the icons on websites, etc.). FYI - - - May 2025 GAB Meeting: DISCUSSION NOTES **Ideas that the GAB wanted to start with in 25-26.

School one-pager ideas:

- Thinking about HS is overwhelming. What would my child get here that they would not get there?
- Hard to decide what would go on the "dot chart" that would be important to the most parents.
- Idea: Do a parent survey. Find out what they want to know as they move into this transition with their child. "What are the top three priorities that you want to know?"
- Digitize the chart (ex: be able to funnel down to clubs at multiple schools)
- MS one pagers? Elem?

Other ideas to help parents in school discussions:

Give parents a list of "key questions" to ask sites as they visit open houses (like sentence starters) - - Look online to see if someone else has questions like this already?

- Give transition parents a packet to help them record information as they investigate the next school/s
- How to support BOTH parents who are looking and parents who are going to their neighborhood school
- Idea Communicate the timeline with 5th grade and 8th grade parents early on
- Idea Transition icon/button on MS and HS websites for 5th and 8th grade parents
- Idea There is no PSD transition webpage (Is there a district that does this well?)
- District department supports in this
 - Curriculum (ex: K-5 literacy curriculum one pagers for all schools to offer at their open houses good for all parents / choice or home school)
