They also participate in a daily enrichment block which focuses on science, social studies and literature units. Advanced Learning Plan process at this school



GT Site Coordinator works in partnership with classroom teachers, grade level teachers, and students to determine achievement and affective goals for the current school year. The student will reflect on his/her goals in January and again in May. The gifted site coordinator assists with monitoring the goal progress.

- · Grouping patterns are both flexible and by ability.
