Our gifted and talented para-professional collaborates with the classroom teachers to meet both affective and academic needs, meeting with identified students in small groups during WIN (What I Need) blocks of time for Literacy and Math.

Programming Opportunities for Gifted Learners

Identified students are pulled in small groups three to five times a week for math and/or literacy enrichment and affective programming, which is delivered by the GT paraprofessional. Additionally, teachers provide differentiated instruction to challenge and enrich student learning within the regular classroom environment.

Shepardson's GT Program:

Our program currently serves students in third through fifth grade identified in the areas of language arts, math, and general intellectual ability.

Advanced Learning Plan process at this school



The team that writes the goals for each student's Advanced Learning Plan consists of the GT Site Coordinator, classroom teacher, instructional para-professional parents/guardians, and the student. This team chooses a goal for reading and/or math, and an affective (social/emotional) goal that will both challenge students and build upon their strengths.

The GT Program provides opportunities for students to discuss struggles and achievements in a safe environment with a trusted adult.
