Programming Opportunities for Gifted Learners

At grades 4 and 5, we offer a compacted math pathway for students who qualify. Qualifying students would receive 4th and half of 5th grade math standards in fourth grade and the other half of 5th and all of 6th grade math standards in fifth grade. Students qualify based on a body of evidence.

In the area of language arts, we believe that the Core Knowledge Sequence is rich with opportunities to stimulate interest and advanced achievement for our ALP students. We also firmly believe that language arts goals are best met within the classroom by the classroom teacher.
