Programming Opportunities for Gifted Learners

Beattie's GT program is specially designed to support GT identified and high-ability learners. Students in grade levels 3-5 spend 30 minutes each day in a WIN (What I Need) group where they experience enrichment opportunities that support critical thinking, divergent/creative thinking, and social emotional skills. ALP's are supported through individualized goal setting and projects based on individual student interests.

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Overview of the GT program at this school



The Gifted and Talented Program at Beattie provides rigorous and engaging learning experiences for students in grades 3-5 who are identified as Gifted as well as Talent Pool students who demonstrate high academic and/or creative abilities.

Advanced Learning Plan process at this school



Beattie utilizes the Poudre School District identification process to identify GT students. GT students work collaboratively with the GT site coordinator to set their academic and social-emotional goals for their Advanced Learning Plans (ALPs). The goals are established early in the year and then revisited in January and May. The GT site coordinator assists with monitoring the goal process.

Enrichment opportunities for GT students during school



At Beattie, every grade level uses the Impact Team Model which provides flexible grouping as needed to accommodate students' specific learning needs. Everyday during WIN (What I Need) time, GT and Talent Pool students have the opportunity to learn with like-minded peers who have similar academic, creative, and social-emotional needs.
