TMHS is dedicated to helping each gifted student develop a meaningful Advanced Learning Plan (ALP) that is integrated with their Individual Career and Academic Plan (ICAP). Each fall, the Gifted Site Coordinator analyzes all academic data for incoming 6th and 9th grade students, as well as new students to the district, to ensure fidelity in the identification process. A unique feature of TMHS is that all students in grades 6-12 maintain their ALP/ICAP in Xello, providing parents and teachers with convenient access.

Programming Opportunities for Gifted Learners

TMHS offers a comprehensive range of advanced learning opportunities to support academic growth and personal development. **Middle school students** may pursue accelerated math pathways, world language courses, and other options that allow them to earn high school credit.

High school students have access to rigorous academic pathways, including FRCC Concurrent Enrollment, Advanced Placement (AP), and CU Succeed courses, providing opportunities to earn college credit while still in high school.

Leadership classes are also available at both the middle and high school levels, fostering confidence and future-ready skills. In addition, all students are offered Junior Achievement programming, which builds financial literacy and career readiness. Intentional gifted enrichment is offered during Cub Connect.
