**SUMMARY:** Responsible for monitoring students in in-school suspension (ISS) and other disciplinary sessions, including maintaining discipline/behavior, monitoring attendance and assisting students with school work. Assist administration with general discipline processes, including attendance, discipline, and incident reports and referrals. Monitor students throughout the school building and grounds.
