Q1	<p>Question: Terms and Conditions Per Condition 1.5 of the RFP:</p> <p>"Submission of a proposal is deemed as acceptance of all terms, conditions and specifications contained in the District's solicitation package initially provided to the Provider. Any proposed modification must be accepted in writing by the District prior to award of the agreement."</p> <p>Are there any additional terms and conditions required by the District beyond the specifications included in the RFP document on the BidNet website entitled, "Before and After School Childcare"?</p> <p>Answer: Paragraph 5.3 states, "The successful Provider(s) will be required to enter into and sign a formal agreement with the District with reasonable adjustments acceptable to the District."</p>	12/17/2019
Q2	<p>Question: References The RFP asks us to provide references from Colorado. While we are currently in talks with several districts in Colorado, Right At School does not currently run programs in the state. We proudly serve over 30,000 students in 15 states. Q4	<p>Question: Rental Fees Can you verify what room(s) will be available at each site as it relates to Tier II rental fees outlined in Exhibit B?</p> <p>Answer: The flex room (cafeteria) and gymnasium are available for before and after school child care. During school out days, including summer break, additional rooms are available, to include classrooms, media center, and art room. Q11	<p>Question: Snow Day Policy Can providers offer on-site care in the case of school being cancelled due to weather?</p> <p>Answer: When schools are cancelled due to weather or other hazardous conditions, both before and after school child care is cancelled, as well. If schools are operating on a two-hour delay or early release due to weather or other conditions, before and after school child care will operate on a normal schedule.</p>	12/18/2019
