Q1	<p>Question: 20-680-003 - District-Wide Intercom System What phone system is Poudre using?</p> <p>Answer: Avaya phone system</p>	10/25/2019
Q2	<p>Question: 20-680-003 - District-Wide Intercom System What approximate number of devices will be replaced in a 12 month period?</p> <p>Answer: We are assuming 'device' means 'intercom system.' All 50+ sites need intercom systems replaced; we would like the work completed as efficiently as possible. Because of the intrusive nature of needing to rewire each classroom (or some other creative solution), most of the work would need to be done in the summers. Therefore, we anticipate the project taking 3-5 years.</p> <p>If 'device' means each subcomponent of a potential intercom system, we wouldn't be able to predict quantities until determinations of all potential options were made.</p>	10/25/2019
Q3	<p>Question: 20-680-003 - District-Wide Intercom System How many desktop computers would you want to send pop-up notifications to?</p> <p>Answer: The District has approximately 5,000 desktops and 30,000 laptops that could fall into this category.</p>	10/25/2019

Q5	<p>Question: Classrooms Per Site It states there are Approximately 1800 classrooms in 50 sites, is it possible to get a per site room breakdown, to more accurately provide pricing?</p> <p>Answer: There are approximately 30 classrooms per elementary school, 45 classrooms per middle school and 75 classrooms per high school. This is an approximation of classrooms and does not take into account offices, gyms, lunchrooms, auditoriums, etc. that will have similar speaker needs.</p>	10/29/2019
Q6	<p>Question: 1.2.1.5 Voice Amplification Is PSD looking at an RF amplification system and are they looking to tie into the classroom projectors?</p> <p>Answer: The District is looking for voice amplification for the teachers via microphone or pendant as a requirement. Tying in the other classroom devices (projectors, TV's, laptops) would be an optional enhancement. Provide pricing for the optional enhancements.</p>	10/29/2019
