5	Art Club	\$20.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of the program including, but not limited to the art supplies.	Students who do not pay will not be allowed to participate.
N/A	McGlee Club Dues	\$25.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of operating McGlee Club including, but not limited to, t-shirts, choir music, accompanist fees, party supplies, and field trip.	All students can participate regardless of whether payment is made.
N/A	Choir: 3 rd Grade	\$5.00	To cover a portion of the cost of supplies for the 3 rd grade choir including, but not limited to, choir music and choir folders.	All 3 rd grade students can participate in the choir regardless of whether payment is made.
