N/A	Course and Course Enrichment: Discovery Program	\$60.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of the program including, but not limited to, expendable supplies and enrichment activities.	All students will be allowed to participate regardless of whether payment is made.
N/A	Course Charge: Equine	\$35.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of the program including, but not limited to, a third-party riding instructor.	All students will be allowed to participate regardless of whether payment is made.
N/A	Course Charge: Art	\$15.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of expendable supplies for stained glass projects, including but not limited to, glass, fusing supplies, and bevels.	All students will be allowed to participate regardless of whether payment is made.
N/A	Yearly Activity Charge	\$25.00	Yearbook, BBQs, field trips, community building activities, school wide activities.	All students will be allowed to participate regardless of whether payment is made.
