



2019 SCHOOL BUS SAFETY POSTER CONTEST

(Sponsored by PSD Transportation Services and NAPT)

Kids – try for a chance to win a brand new bike and helmet while you have fun drawing!

Winning posters may go on to compete at the State and National levels.

The theme for the poster contest is:

Red Lights Mean Stop!

PSD Transportation will select two winners, one from Grades K – 2 (Division #1) and one from Grades 3 -5 (Division #2)! The posters are due to your teacher by **Monday, April 22, 2019.**

It is important that you follow these Guidelines so that your poster will not be disqualified:

- Completed poster **must be 11" x 17" or 12" x 18"** and may be vertical or horizontal
- The theme **Red Lights Mean Stop!** (must include all punctuation), should be on the front of the poster and be done freehand only. Cut paper/stencils (freehand or pre-drawn stick-on stencils) are NOT PERMITTED and will disqualify the poster.
- Posters should be submitted on tag, poster illustration board or heavy paper. Construction paper may be used but winning entries must be mounted on quality tag poster.
- There is no limitation on type of media such as print, crayon, felt pen, etc. used on the poster design but wood, plastic, glass or metal should NOT be part of the poster.
- Collage materials should NOT be used
- Glued on pieces will disqualify the poster
- Poster designs MAY NOT include copyrighted characters, photographs or magazine/newspaper illustrations
- **At least part of a yellow school bus must be present on the poster**
- Do not put name, school, etc. on the front of the poster, all information should be **on the back only.**
- Do not laminate the poster
- **Do not roll the poster, it must be delivered flat**

Criteria for the selection of award winning posters are:

- a) The theme, **Red Lights Mean Stop!** must be included in the poster design (**be sure to include all punctuation**).
- b) Relationship of the poster design to the school bus safety practices.
- c) Originality of the poster and how the idea is expressed in the poster design.
- d) Artwork and its execution. **A portion of a yellow school bus must be present in the poster.**
- e) Visual impact of the poster design.
