X	National Honor Society Dues – 11 th Grade	\$10.00	To cover all or a portion of the cost of induction ceremony, member meeting materials, scholarship breakfast, and national dues.	Students who do not pay will not receive national club recognition but may be a member of the club.
X	National Honor Society Dues – 12 th Grade	\$15.00	To cover the cost of induction ceremony, member meeting materials, scholarship breakfast, senior tassels, and national dues. X	National Technical Honor Society	\$40.00	To cover the cost of the students purchasing their own National Tech Honor Society membership.	Students who do not pay will not be allowed to participate.
X	National Business Honor Society	\$30.00	To cover the cost of the national membership in National Business Honor Society.	Students who do not pay will not be allowed to participate.
X	International Thespian Society	\$15.00	To cover the cost of the individual National Thespian Society Membership.	Students who do not pay will not receive a national membership.
X	Tri-M (National Music Honor Society)	\$30.00	To cover the cost of national chapter registration fee, and club supplies.	Students who do not pay will not be allowed to participate.
