No	Math Counts	\$25.00	To cover the cost of Northern Regionals and State Competition entry fees.	Students who do not pay will not be allowed to participate.
No	Science Olympiad	\$100.00 <sup>C</sup>	To cover the cost of the program including registration, tournament fees and supplies such as balsa wood, glue, wood, and batteries.	Students who do not pay will not be allowed to participate.
No	Speech and Debate	\$20.00 <sup>C</sup>	To cover the cost of the program including materials and supplies.	Students who do not pay will not be allowed to participate.

- B. Fee waivers are available for PSD students only. To be eligible for a fee waiver, the student must be approved to receive free or reduced priced meals in the 2025school year and a Permission to Share Information for Fee/Charge Wavier and Programs to Receive Goods and Services form must be on file with the extracurricular option selected. “N/A” signifies that the fee is a voluntary payment; there will be no consequence to students who do not pay, regardless of waiver status.
- C. In addition to the participation fee, there may be additional voluntary activity fee and/or other charges, including but not limited to travel and registration costs and uniforms and other equipment. Additional charges are not subject to the waiver.
