

Exhibit C – Scope of Work
South Transportation Terminal
Fueling Station Design and Installation

Poudre School District currently has a contract with the City of Fort Collins to fuel diesel school buses at the Transfort facility at 6570 Portner Rd, Fort Collins, CO. This facility is used primarily by school buses that operate out of Poudre School District’s South Transportation Terminal at 6425 Portner Rd, Fort Collins, CO.

The City of Fort Collins has transitioned away from diesel buses and has advised Poudre School District of their intent to close their diesel fueling pumps. Due to this, Poudre School District has purchased a 10,000 gallon, UL 2085 rated, fuel tank for their South Transportation Terminal and is seeking proposals that include a site plan and installation costs for a fueling station on the property of the South Transportation Terminal at 6425 Portner Rd, Fort Collins, CO.

Poudre School District anticipates this single tank (10,000 gallon) station to be located at the furthest west property line of the South Transportation Facility. Poudre School District is seeking a proposed site plan that includes site preparation for tank installation, and installation of all equipment necessary for two single hose dispensers that would allow for two 77 passenger buses to fuel simultaneously. Poudre School District seeks to have this fuel station have the least amount of impact on the current paved area at the west property line of the South Transportation Terminal.

Anticipated work includes site design and site preparation needed to set a 10,000 gallon, UL 2085, horizontal fuel tank. Anticipated work shall also include site preparation necessary to install two single hose dispensers at a distance to allow simultaneous fueling of two 77-passenger buses. installation of all piping, electrical, data, and other infrastructure necessary for pump operation and data transmission. Installation of any necessary lighting for safe nighttime operation of the fueling station.
