



• Poudre School District is committed to helping our students and our staff members succeed. The Wellness Department follows research that demonstrates that movement throughout the school day facilitates cognition, maximizes brain function and anchors learning. Highly regarded researchers such as John Ratey, Eric Jensen, John Medina, David Sousa, and Jean Blaydes all concur that movement and physical activity is vital to cognitive development. Active Classrooms are kindly supported by The Colorado Health Foundation and the Antioch Foundation.

To support movement through out the school day, The PSD Wellness program will fund Active Classrooms in the district. PSD currently has movement desks at Cache La Poudre Middle School, Rocky Mountain High School, Irish Elementary, Poudre High School, Putnam Elementary, and Preston Middle School. Teachers will be able to fund up to **\$12,000** in active seating. All Poudre School District teachers are eligible to apply.

- A maximum of up to \$12,000 in desk will be awarded based upon application.
- Classrooms are subject to evaluation from PSD Wellness.
- Funds must be spent on active seating only
