


# Literacy Data

#### Acadience Reading K-3





#### MAP Reading 2nd-8th

#### **Graduation Rates**






# Mental Health Data

- The biggest proactive factor in preventing youth suicide is youth having a positive adult with whom they connect


# S PSD Priorities Coming Into Focus
