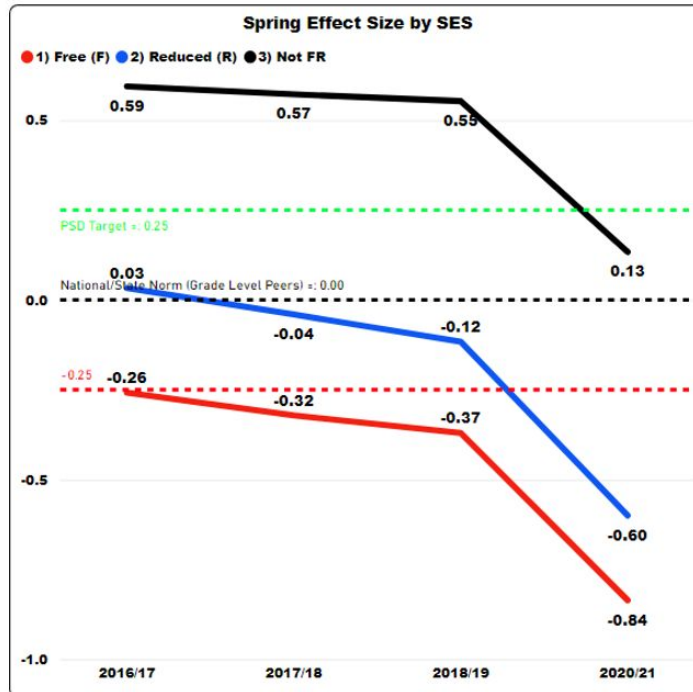




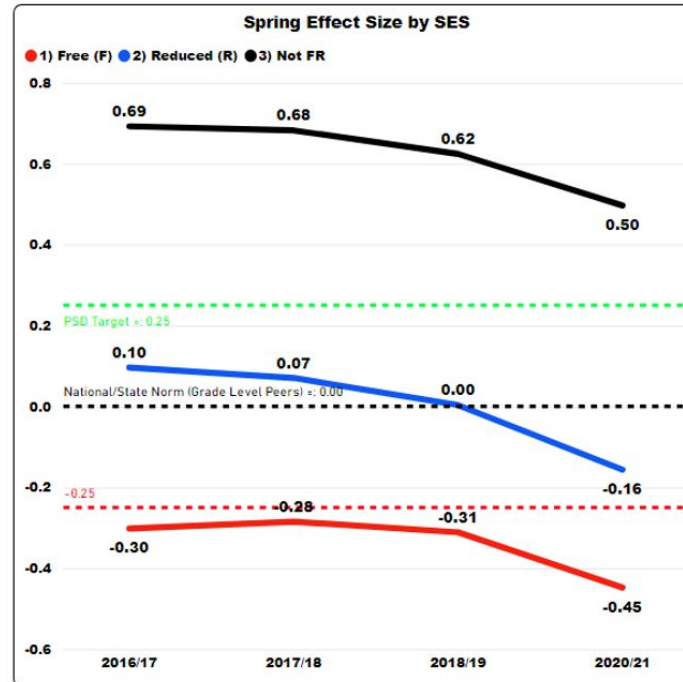


## Literacy Data

### Acadience Reading K-3



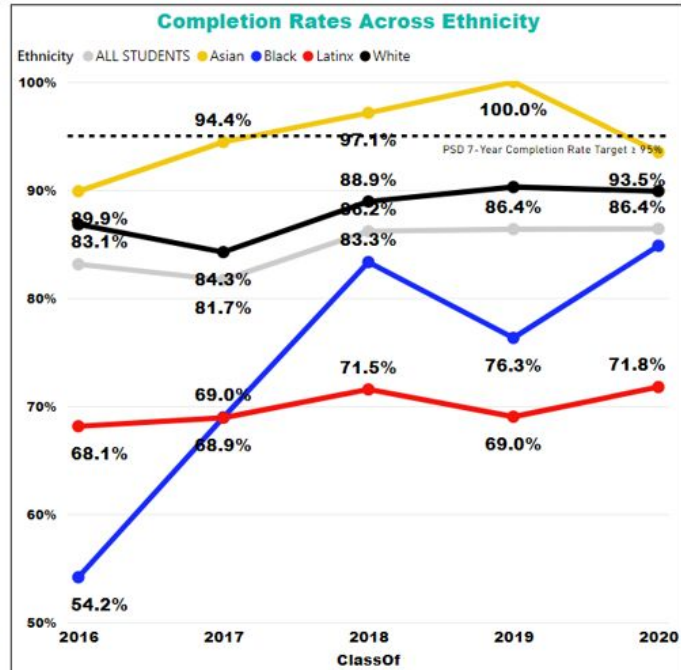
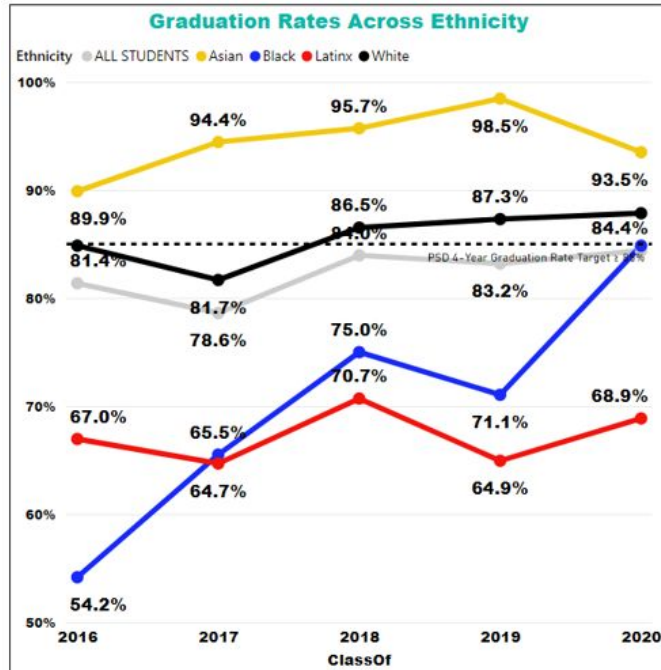
### MAP Reading 2nd-8th

## Mental Health Data

- 13-20% of students meet criteria for a mental health disorder each year
