Q4 Ice Melt Pricing

Is the requested ice melt price for the per-ton application of District-provided ice melt, the contractor's supply of ice melt, or the contractor's supply and application of ice melt?

The requested ice melt price is per-ton if District needs to purchase salt from contractor. It is also a cost per-ton if the District requests the contractor to use their own salt when salting opposed to District provided salt.

Separately there is a cost per hour for salt truck listed under (T&M) which wouldn't the cost of salt (material) that they spread.
