Misc: Mild asthma exacerbations, short-term pharmaceutical refills. Chronic Conditions: Short-term issues related to chronic conditions. (E.g. Diabetes w/ high glucose levels, high blood pressure. All chronic conditions should be primarily managed by PCP and/or subspecialists)

In-Office Point of Care Labs:

Rapid influenza antigen testing.

Worker's Compensation injuries or occupationally related illnesses: Staff can provide initial evaluation and treatment if so approved by PSD. All services rendered will be billed to PSD Worker's Compensation carrier. All complex injuries or injuries requiring recurring f/u will be referred to workers comp clinic.

Newborn, infant and preschool well child exams and immunizations. Participants should be encouraged to have these exams done through the PCP office.
